NIDA and ICO NIDA

The National Institute of Development Administration (NIDA) was established following His Majesty King Bhumibol Adulyadej's vision of advancing Thailand's development through the establishment of an advanced educational institution to prepare people to become agents of change for national development.

The inception of NIDA grew out of His Majesty the King's discussions of the country's development with Mr. David Rockefeller of the Rockefeller Foundation in the United States of America in 1963. As a result, NIDA was established on April 1, 1966.

International College of National Institute of Development Administration (ICO NIDA) initiated in 2010 by Professor Dr. Sombat Thamrongthanyawong, 13th President of NIDA. ICO NIDA has the major aim to provide higher education and training that can enhance the competitiveness of the country and to create truly international learning environment for graduate studies.

ICO NIDA has set the objectives as follows.

1. To produce management graduates who have potential to work in different parts of the world in the areas such as public sector, private sector, non-profit organization, social enterprises and business entrepreneurship etc.

Admission requirement

The candidate must hold at least a bachelor's degree in any field or currently undertaking final year of bachelor degree from an institution in Thailand or abroad, or another educational qualification approved by ICO NIDA. Acceptance into ICO NIDA requires a student to have a record of academic excellence, satisfactory English test scores and sound recommendations. All submitted documents are considered in a complete review of an applicant's credentials.

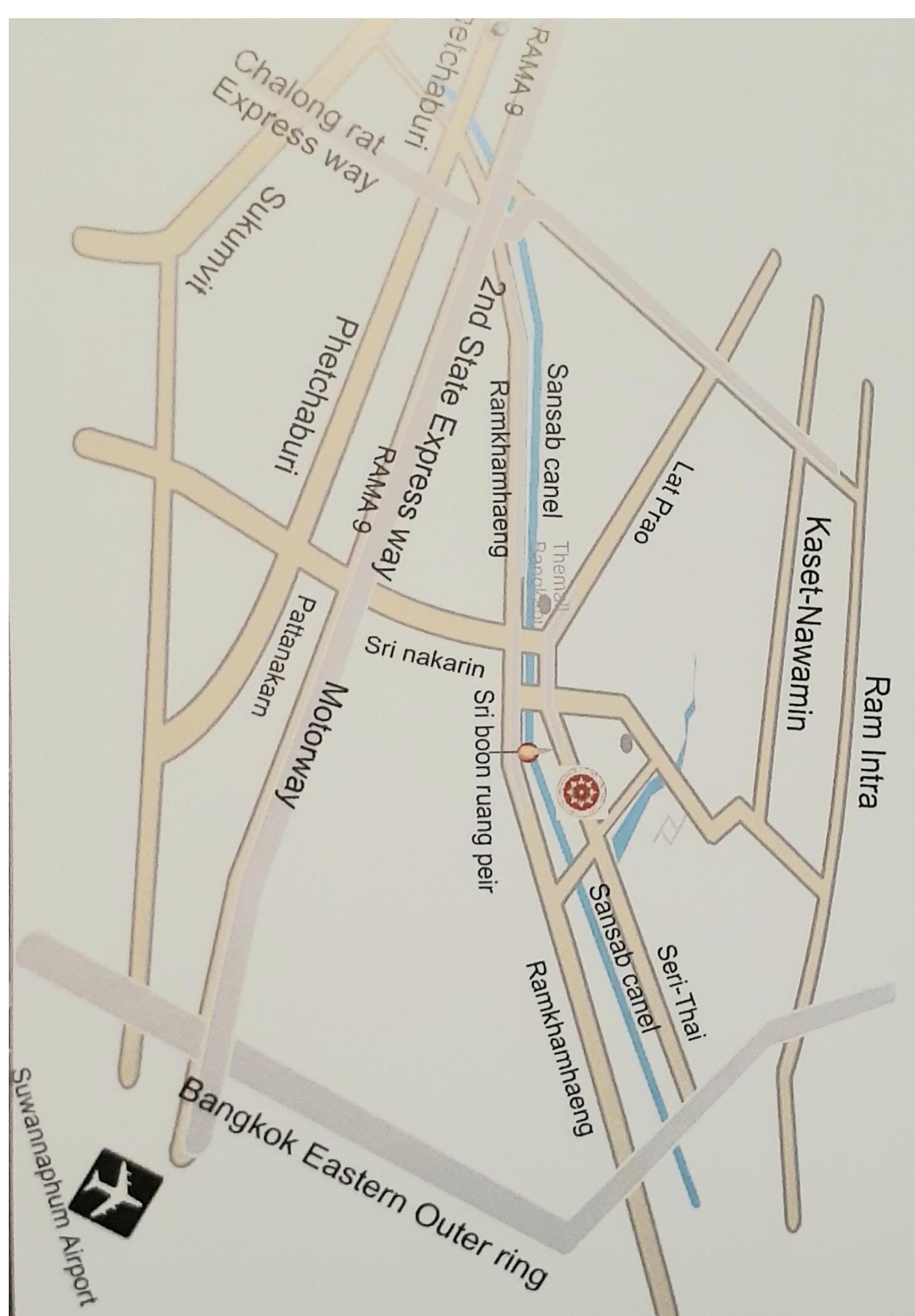
